

# Federation Bursaries Closing Date Extended!

The bursary draws will still take place later in the year, so we have extended the closing date. Please send in the slip below or email to [finance@norfolkwi.org.uk](mailto:finance@norfolkwi.org.uk). The time limits will be extended, and we will advise you of the closing date when the postponed Federation Annual Meeting has been rescheduled.

The following Bursaries will be awarded in 2020. Some of the Bursaries have restrictions, some can only be used at Denman College but others are available for local courses so do make sure that you only apply for what you could use. You can apply for as many Bursaries as you would like but, if successful, you will only be awarded one

1. Fakenham Afternoon WI Bursary - covers the basic cost of any Denman College course of your choice
2. 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Bursary - £300 towards the cost of a course at Denman College
3. Patricia Batty Shaw Bursary - £200 To be used for any educational course held in Norfolk
4. June Van Poortvliet - £150 To be used towards an environmental / conservation course
5. Miss Catleugh - £150 To be used for any Norfolk Federation run course(s)
6. Cecily McCall - £150 – towards the cost of a course at Denman College

But that's not all, three WIs will be awarded programme planning bursaries of £200 each. You don't need to apply for these - all WIs who haven't previously won are automatically entered for this draw.

**Please be aware of the time limits on Bursaries (for 2020 these will be amended and advised in due course)**

1. Winners of Bursaries (members or WIs) must write to the Federation by 1<sup>st</sup> October in the year the Bursary is drawn to advise what the award will be used for.
2. The Bursary must be spent and the money claimed from the Federation by 1<sup>st</sup> October the year after it is drawn.
3. For Bursaries without a financial limit, the winners must write to the Federation by 1<sup>st</sup> October in the year it is drawn, to advise what the Bursary will be used for and the approximate cost. The Bursary must be spent and the money claimed from the Federation by 1<sup>st</sup> October the year after it is drawn.
4. This does not apply for fixed sum Denman Bursaries, for which vouchers are purchased and sent to award winners immediately following the draw.
5. All Bursary winners must write a report to the Board of Trustees.
