## “Easy Peasy” Fingerless Mitts

These fingerless mitts are very easy to make and could be made using oddments of left over wool. Sizes are approximate and can be made bigger, or smaller, by varying the number of stitches and rows.

### Materials

50g Double knitting wool  
1 pair 4mm knitting needles  
1 pair 3.25mm knitting needles

### Method

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 40 stitches and work 6 rows in knit 2, purl 2.

Change to 4mm needles and continue working in stocking stitch (Knit 1 row, purl 1 row) until work measures approximately 20 cm.

Change back to 3.25mm needles and work 6 rows in K2, purl 2. Cast off.

Made a second mitt.

### Make up

Fold the work so that the right sides are together. Then stitch along the sides edges from one end for 16 cm. Stitch from the opposite end for 4cm. This will leave a gap for the “thumb hole”.
