WOMEN'S INSTITUTE CONSTITUTION AND RULES

I NAME Bridewell

The name of the Institute is 'The Wymonsham Women's Institute' (hereinafter referred to as 'the Institute').

II CHARACTER AND OBJECTS

CHARACTER—The Women's Institute movement is based on the spiritual ideals of fellowship, truth, tolerance and justice. All countrywomen are eligible for membership, no matter what their views on religion or politics may be. The movement is non-sectarian and non-party-political.

OBJECTS—The main purpose of the Women's Institute movement is to improve and develop conditions of rural life. It seeks to give to all countrywomen the opportunity of working together through the Women's Institute organization, and of putting into practice those ideals for which it stands.
