The production is set in the 1960s and retains its sun-drenched Sicilian setting. The play's thoroughly modern heroine Beatrice shakes up the old order with a new spirit of liberation, as she determines not to be "overmastered". An original score of music, composed especially for the show by the wonderful Tamara Douglas-Morris and inspired by everything from Italian pop music of the period to traditional Tarantella, accompanies this thoughtfully adapted script.
