It can be amusing or serious, the choice of subject is yours!

All we ask is:

- that your poem is no longer than 24 lines.
- It can be Handwritten or typed, but well presented, remember the layout of a poem is part of the poetry. An illustration may be included as an optional extra.

Please also

- Do not put your name on the poem itself, but attach a cover sheet with your name, address, phone and/or email contact, and the name of your WI. Include a sae if you want the poem returned by post.
- Submit your entry and your fee to Federation Office, either by email (admin@norfolkwi.org.uk) or by post to 45 All Saints Green, Norwich, NR1 3LY
 - By cheque payable to NFWI. On reverse write 'Poem 2022' and the name of your WI
 - BACs to NFWI Sort Code 08-92-99, account number 65431449, please reference with Your Surname, WI and Poem 2022
- The winner will be invited to the Poetry Day event on 6th October to share their poem and will be presented with a Certificate at the Federation Annual Meeting in 2023.
- Winner and runners-up will be asked to allow publication in the Magazine or online.
