Things to do & Other Useful Information

- **Bishop's House Open Garden**: celebrating 250 years of the N&N Hospital. Sunday, 31st July 1pm-4.30pm (last entry 4pm). Adults £5, Children/Wheelchair users free
- The WI's 5 Minutes that Matters Campaign: National is working with King's College London to promote a study about cervical screening, by Cancer Research UK. The researchers are looking for women aged

25-64 in England to take part in an online survey. The survey is about the use of pictures and other information in cervical screening materials; it will help improve understanding of cervical screening attitudes and uptake. This is a pilot study and will provide valuable insights to inform the final survey which will be conducted with a larger and representative sample of women. While National has not been involved in the development or delivery of this research, they are promoting it as they feel it is a valuable opportunity for members to contribute to important research aimed at improving cervical screening. The survey is open to everyone who meets the eligibility requirements, so members are welcome to share the details widely. The survey can be completed anonymously, should take around 10 minutes to complete and is open until 4th July. The survey link is:

- **Spot the signs of holiday fraud:** Action Fraud has launched a national awareness campaign to think twice before handing over money and personal information when booking holidays. The number of fraud reports has substantially increased over 120%. Victims reported losing a total of over £7.3million an average loss of £1,868 per victim. - How to report scam texts and mobile calls to 7726: 7726 is a number that most mobile customers using UK networks can text to report unwanted SMS messages or phone calls on a mobile. The number '7726' was chosen because it spells 'SPAM' on an alphanumeric phone keypad that's a handy way of remembering it.
