Coffee Ladies (Catherine 07879426579 or Kate 07779620340) Usually Friday 10.30 at Roots but other venues are tried.

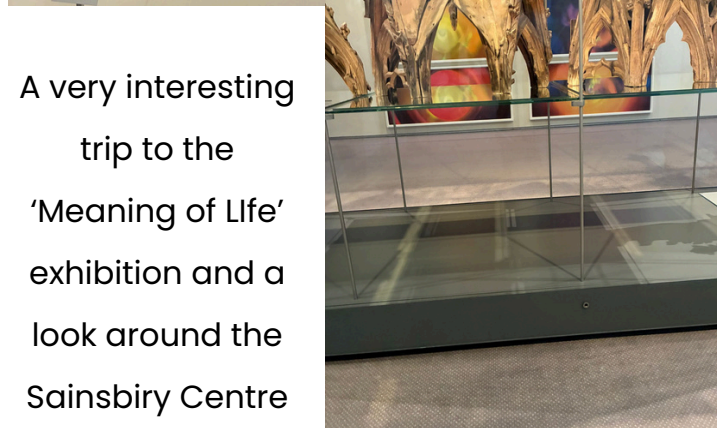
Quiz Group (Kate)We take part in the Football club fortnightly quiz on a Sunday 8pm. Always on the lookout for members.
